

Check List of Suggested Items

The following check list of suggested items to bring for the camp out was provided by camper Michael Kaye. It is not meant to be all inclusive.

- Tent*
- Air mattress*
- Sleeping bag*/bedding/Pillow
- Blankets
- 25 ft. outdoor extension cord (electricity is available in the tenting areas)
- Power strip for inside you tent to plug things into
- Fan
- Small light
- Umbrella/rain poncho — “just in case”
- Sweatshirt, sweater, or light jacket (it sometimes gets cold at night)
- Hiking boots — please see foot wear recommendations
- Medications
- Clothesline (to hang your towel on)
- Decorative lights for your camp site
- Laptop (Wi-Fi is available for \$10 for the weekend)
- A cell phone charger with electric cord, etc. Cell phone service is very spotty. Text messages do seem to get through — eventually
- Toiletries
- Camp chair
- Plastic mug for your coffee or cocktails (saves on plastic cups)
- Anything else — remember we’re gay and it’s all fun. We accessorize and decorate!
- Clothes (remember the camp out is clothing optional for those who enjoy being nude)
